Radionic Thoughts by Pennsylvania Pete

Welcome to my second letter on Radionics for the Kelly Research Report.

When I have no idea what to do next to help an animal who is suffering I resort to cold scanning. The problem with cold scanning is to clearly know what you want to scan for. In this case, intent is critical. For this reason my cold scan “wording” tends to be either a bit long or very short. One of the most powerful cold scan wordings that I have found is simply, “provide the witness what is needed most with harm to no one” followed by “provide the witness what is NEXT needed most with harm to no one”. Usually I will fill all three banks of my Kelly Ag Workstation and if time permits, or if I feel the need is great, I will do this three or more times in a day. This is not a substitute for doing the worksheets. It does however seem to have a powerful and almost instantly noticeable result.

Recently I have been reading the book, “Radionics and the Subtle Anatomy of Man” by David V. Tansley, D.C. The book is published by The C.W. Daniel Company Limited in Essex, UK and has an ISBN of 0-8464-1044-3. It is distributed in the USA by Beekman Books (www.beekmanbooks.com) but I purchased my copy on www.amazon.com. The book was first published in 1972 and my copy is part of the ninth impression made in October 1988. I enjoyed this book. I was disappointed in the fact that it did not contain more detailed instruction specific to using an instrument but then it is not too hard to figure out how to apply the knowledge in this book directly. Lately a statement by one of my teachers (Hi Guys) keeps coming to mind. The statement was attributed to Peter Kelly and is, “Look for the cause behind the cause, behind the cause.” I may have stated this incorrectly but the idea is there. This statement keeps lingering on my mind and the knowledge that it is a powerful idea keeps me thinking about it. This book may provide some insights into helping me understand this statement.

Several of the books that I have read all talk about Chakras and Rays. I believe that chakras exist but I have also found that books contradict each other on which chakras exist and where they exist. Some books state that the chakras exist on the front of the body, some on the back and some that the chakras are on both the front and back. There are also some books that discuss minor Chakras which are placed in other spots within the body. [Tansley’s] book also names what I think of as the Brow Chakra as the Ajna Chakra. In either case these are minor problems. What is important is that the author makes some bold statements that are interesting when thinking about the cause behind, etc. On Page 40, the author states, “Dysfunction of the solar plexus chakra is said to be one of the most potent causes of cancer. Certain reactions between this centre and the heart chakra cause congestion of the solar plexus centre.” It goes on to attribute specific chakras with specific problems. The author uses homeopathic words to describe the kind of problems that a chakra can be afflicted with. I find these words too complex but on page 70 the author states, “I have found that treatment of the chakras eliminates them (the problems) anyhow, without them having been identified in detail.” On page 71 he gives the reason why he believes this as, “Treatment of just the miasms or toxins in the etheric body is a very one sided approach.... Frequently “animals” who are treated in this manner may find very little difference in their health.... The reason for this is simply because the chakras which supply energy to the etheric-physical body are not functioning correctly, and, until they are, ill health will be the lot of such”. Wow, that is a statement and then some.

As of yet, I have not balanced chakras but Buddhist friends do this on a regular basis and believe that keeping a well functioning chakra is critical. As you can see from the quotes, the author of this book is quite bold. You can believe or not in his statements but if you want to learn more about what else he has to say then this is a book worth reading.

I am not an expert in chakras but I do intend to learn more.



Chakra: Gateways to the Energy Universe

Hindu tradition states that the subtle body of any advanced animal has seven major chakra – energy centers that receive, assimilate and express bioenergetic life force energy through the living organism. In this way, they act as portals between the physical realm that binds all physical creatures and the living universe of pure energy that exists beyond.

Derived from the Sanskrit word “cakram”, the word chakra literally translates as “wheel” - a reference to the description of the chakra as spinning spheres of living energy that are stacked in a column from the base of the spine to the uppermost region of the brain.

Much of Eastern healing is based on the idea that a free flow of energy to and through the chakra is a driving force behind the performance of both the nervous system and the endocrine system. Eliminating blockages and improving the flow of energy through the chakra, the meridians and the surrounding auric bodies is believed to be necessary to improve performance from the nerves, glands and organs that play such a large role in day-to-day physical and emotional well-being. Cited as evidence is the direct overlap in the positioning and interrelationship of the endocrine glands, the major nerve ganglia and the chakra in the body - as well as their respective pathways of nerves, ducts and energy meridians.



Absolutely fundamental to radionics is this concept that the physical realm is a reflection of that same universe of pure energy that feeds the chakra. It is the flow of this energy that a radionic researcher seeks to influence through the application of focused intent via the amplifying lens that is the radionics instrument. In the higher-order living organisms, the chakra serve as the primary intersection points between that infinite universe of pure energy and the much-constrained universe of physical matter that we know as reality. As such, maintaining a free flow of energy to and through all of the chakra of an organism is absolutely pivotal to maintaining the physical state of the creature. In some cases the imbalance itself may be revealed as the ultimate “cause behind the cause” in the situation being investigated.

Understanding the Seven Chakra

Here is a more detailed look at each of the primary chakra. While the source materials utilized approach this discussion from within the human context, the information may also be extrapolated to other vertebrate animals, such as livestock.



Sahasrara: The Crown Chakra

Sahasrara is generally considered to be the chakra of pure consciousness. Its role may be envisioned somewhat similarly to that of the pituitary gland, which secretes hormones to communicate with the rest of the endocrine system and also connects to the central nervous system via the hypothalamus. The thalamus is thought to have a key role in the physical basis of consciousness. Symbolized by a lotus with one thousand petals, it is located at the crown of the head. Sahasrara is represented by the colour violet and it involves such issues as inner wisdom and the death of the body. Sahasrara's inner aspect deals with the release of karma, physical action with meditation, mental action with universal consciousness and unity, and emotional action with "beingness".



Ajna: The Brow Chakra Ajna (along with Bindu, also known as the third eye chakra) is linked to the pineal gland. The pineal gland is a light sensitive gland that produces the hormone melatonin, which regulates sleep and awakening. Ajna is symbolised by a lotus with two petals, and corresponds to the colour white, indigo or deep blue. Anja's key issues involve balancing the higher & lower selves and trusting inner guidance. Anja's inner aspect relates to the access of intuition. Emotionally, Ajna deals with clarity on an intuitive level.



Vishuddha: The Throat Chakra

Vishuddha (also Vishuddhi) may be understood as relating to communication and growth through expression. This chakra is paralleled to the thyroid, a gland that is also in the throat and which produces thyroid hormone, responsible for growth and maturation. Symbolised by a lotus with sixteen petals. Vishuddha is characterized by the color light or pale blue, or turquoise. Physically, Vishuddha governs communication, emotionally it governs independence, mentally it governs fluent thought, and spiritually, it governs a sense of security.



Anahata: The Heart Chakra

Anahata, or Anahata-puri, or padma-sundara is related to the thymus, located in the chest. The thymus is an element of the immune system as well as being part of the endocrine system. It produces the T cells responsible for fending off disease and may be adversely affected by stress. Anahata is symbolised by a lotus flower with twelve petals. Anahata is related to the colours green or pink. Key issues involving Anahata involve complex emotions, compassion, tenderness, unconditional love, equilibrium, rejection and well being. Physically Anahata governs circulation, emotionally it governs unconditional love for the self and others, mentally it governs passion, and spiritually it governs devotion.



Manipura: The Solar Plexus Chakra

Manipura or manipuraka is related to the metabolic and digestive systems. Manipura is believed to correspond to Islets of Langerhans, which are groups of cells in the pancreas, as well as the outer adrenal glands and the adrenal cortex. These play a valuable role in digestion, and the conversion of food matter into energy for the body. Symbolised by a lotus with ten petals. The colour that corresponds to Manipura is yellow. Key issues governed by Manipura are issues of personal power, fear, anxiety, opinion-formation, introversion, and transition from simple or base emotions to complex. Physically, Manipura governs digestion, mentally it governs personal power, emotionally it governs expansiveness, and spiritually, all matters of growth.



Svadisthana: The Sacral Chakra


Svadisthana or adhishtana, located in the sacrum, is considered to correspond to the testes or ovaries that produce the various sex hormones involved in the reproductive cycle. Svadisthana is also considered to be related to, more generally, the genitourinary

system and the adrenals. The Sacral Chakra is symbolized by a lotus with six petals, and corresponds to the colour orange. The key issues involving Svadisthana are relationships, violence, addictions, basic emotional needs, and pleasure. Physically, Svadisthana governs reproduction, mentally it governs creativity, emotionally it governs joy, and spiritually it governs enthusiasm.




Muladhara: The Base Chakra

Muladhara or root chakra is related to instinct, security, survival and also to basic human potentiality. This centre is located in the region between the genitals and the anus. Although no endocrine organ is placed here, it is said to relate to the gonads and the adrenal medulla, responsible for the fight and flight response when survival is under threat. In this region is located a muscle that controls ejaculation in the sexual act in the human male. A parallel is charted between the sperm cell and the ovum where the genetic code lies coiled and the kundalini. Muladhara is symbolised by a lotus with four petals and the colour red. Key issues involve sexuality, lust and obsession. Physically, Muladhara governs sexuality, mentally it governs stability, emotionally it governs sensuality, and spiritually it governs a sense of security.



These simplified diagrams illustrate the general locations of the chakra in higher level non-human organisms.



Report from the Field: *Evidence of Airborne Ethylene Dibromide (EDB)*

The following report was delivered from a long time friend of KRT who holds a very strong working knowledge of radionics. Clearly poisons like EDB – a jet fuel additive and pesticide - would pose a risk to plants and livestock as they enter the soil and/or the water table.



Was looking out my window and could see what would appear to the inexperienced to be a spider web about 12 inches in diameter. This object was lying on top of the grass about four feet from the house. It occurred to me that this was not a spider web so I got two wooden stem q-tips, my camera and went outside. The texture was more like a fine mesh rather than a web produced by a spider.



I took a picture of the object described after I had captured half of it on each end of one of the q-tips. I secured the other part with the other q-tip until all of it was in my possession. I proceeded to put it into glass specimen tubes for further analysis. I proceeded to find several other similar sightings around the yard, all much smaller.

The sample was tested for the following and these energy levels were observed:

The energetic strength of EDB and most other poisons may be reduced by broadcasting on an identifying rate, or by scanning for a rate with the intent focused on safe elimination. In all cases, test for appropriateness before turning on the amplifier. Remember: Keep your eyes open and be ready to expect the unexpected as this researcher has done!

Chakra: Applications and Techniques


Working with the Chakra

Beyond their associations with the organs and other parts of the body, many believe that the chakra are also linked through specific sounds, colors, frequencies and other characteristics. Most well known among these are the chants and intonations utilized by Tibetan monks and other Eastern spiritualists, who would also benefit from the physical resonance of the body by the act of chanting. In a pre-radionics world, these methods were the only tools available for chakra activation for the purpose of improving energy flow and clearing any blockages. However, with the mighty tool of radionics, the researcher has the option of directly impacting these important energy centers.

Step 1: Balance the Aura

The aura is the multi-layered living energy field generated by all living creatures. It is essentially the outer perimeter of the plumes of energy that flow in all directions from the chakra, and is comparable to the light that reaches from the flame on a candle toward the darkest corners of the room. Having a free flow of energy through the layers of the aura is thus essential to achieving a free flow of energy through the chakra.

1. **Check Aura Coordination** (37-22). The intensity detected should be equal to General Vitality (09-49) of the animal.
2. **Check Aura Distortion** (43-28). The intensity detected should be no more than 1/10 of the reading captured for Aura Coordination.
3. **Balance.** An aura imbalance would be noted if either of the above tests failed. Broadcast on Aura Distortion (43-28) for time indicated on the intensity dial with the amplifier on.



Step 2: Balance the Auric Bodies

Seven major layers of the aura have been identified, each defined with a specific scalar energy pattern and each associated with a specific chakra. These "auric bodies" may be individually assessed for balance through comparison with General Vitality (09-49).

When an auric body is found to be out of balance with General Vitality:

1. Set Bank 1 of the instrument on the rate for the out of balance auric body.
2. Set Bank 2 of the instrument on the rate for Aura Distortion (43-28).
3. Broadcast for the time indicated on the intensity dial with the amplifier on.

Step 3: Balance the Chakra

Once the aura is in balance, each of the seven chakra should be individually assessed for balance through comparison with General Vitality (09-49).

When a chakra is found to be out of balance with General Vitality, broadcast directly on the radionic rate for that chakra for the time indicated on the intensity dial with the amplifier on.

Use of Reagents

Each of the chakra have harmonic relationships with other energy patterns, including those associated with colors, frequencies and even gemstones/minerals. An easy way to impact broadcast times and overall effectiveness when balancing chakra or their corresponding auric bodies is to add those energy patterns. Physical reagents like colored glass beads and mineral specimens in test tubes may be added directly to the specimen input well, while electronic signals like frequencies may be added through the BNC electronic frequency input port. Whenever considering use of a reagent, remember to check for appropriateness and effectiveness:

1. Assess energetic level ("intensity") of the chakra or auric body in question.
2. Add the reagent to the input well or the frequency to the BNC port.
3. Recheck energetic level of the chakra or auric body. If the intensity goes up, the reagent is helpful. If the intensity drops, the reagent is not beneficial in that situation.



Facing a Health Challenge II

When faced with life's health challenges it is important to remember and take action upon those sources of strength, energy and power that have brought us forward through the trials of the past. Whereas the previous list was focused on broad and sometimes philosophical concepts, this is a list of specific alternative modalities to explore as possible complements to conventional medicine.

Acupuncture and/or Acupressure – a centuries-old system of healing that seeks to improve the flow of energy between and to the meridians – the energy pathways that link the chakra.

Affirmations are very much like prayers or positive mental imagery, imprinting in the mind's eye through repetition to bring about a positive influence. "All is well in my world", is a favorite example. The book *You Can Heal Your Life* by Louise Hay is an excellent introduction to this topic. Affirmations can be a very powerful and useful tool in the protocol you develop for your health challenge.

Aromatherapy uses volatile liquid plant materials, known as essential oils, and other aromatic compounds from plants for the purpose of affecting a person's mood or health. Use of aromatic essential oils is one of the oldest forms of healing medicine in the world.

Baths and Soaks can help to flush the body of poisons and toxins while maintaining the body's largest elimination organ – the skin. Minerals may be employed to bring about specific results.

Cell Tissue Salts. Dr. William Schuessler's Biochemic System of Medicine described 12 cell or tissue salts that are normally present in healthy blood and tissues. Dr. Schuessler believed that these 12 salts are the workers, the builders of the cells of the body which combine with organic substances in the creation and maintenance of the millions of cells of which the body is composed. Thus, any cell, tissue-salt deficiency, or imbalance, may result in disease, the symptoms varying according to the salt which is lacking. There are many books that relate to this topic.

Chiropractic Keeping the spine in proper position eliminates many of the internal and external pressures that may be contributing to the health challenge, while also relieving the pain and discomfort of pinched nerves, kinked necks and many of the other indignities of life after age 25.

Color is pure vibration energy that can directly impact living things – ask a plant if you don't believe it! There are many schools of thought as to how it may be employed, from Dinshah P. Ghadiali's famous Spectro-Chrome therapy to the classic rules of thumb – that red light adds fiery energy to a situation, while at the other end of the rainbow, cool blues and violets remove energy and calm things down. Light and color may have a role to play in any health challenge.

Far-Infrared Saunas drive detoxification of the body through the skin through sweating. Unlike traditional saunas with air temperatures so hot they take your breath away, the radiant heat from the infrared lamps penetrate more deeply and produce more sweat without the gasping.

Homeopathy A very knowledgeable homeopathic practitioner is vital particularly when there are health challenges. Homeopathy offers many the ability to establish a non-toxic protocol.

Massage There are many benefits from the manipulation, methodical pressure, friction and kneading of the body, including the hands, feet, ears and tapping of the chest in location of the thymus gland. Massage improves circulation, relieves muscle tension and feels wonderful.

Neural Emotional Technique (NET) may play an important part in establishing a protocol thanks to its focus on resolution of learned biologic responses to distant emotional trauma.

Of course, this list is only a handful of the alternative modalities that one may wish to pursue.

In time the 10-channel BETAR amplifier was modified to include new circuitry that produced seven pulsed frequencies known for their relaxation-inducing influence on the human brain, then seamlessly integrated them with the music. It was no coincidence that six of the frequencies were also chosen for their resonant relationships with the lower six chakra. Like keys slipping gently into locks, these frequencies would activate the chakra easily and naturally, encouraging energy to flow freely through the BETAR user and positively impacting all systems. The seventh frequency was 7.83 hertz – Schumann's Earth resonance frequency and the heart of the company's E.L.F. coil antenna relaxation devices.

Don and Cindy wanted to bring all of the benefits of BETAR to their massage and reflexology customers, but the volume of the music from five tables was sure to overpower the whole building. I had pointed out that a very effective BETAR ride could actually be completely free of audible music thanks to the relaxation-inducing properties of the seven frequencies. From there we set out to design a Stealth Edition BETAR system – one that was designed to run silently.

To ensure top quality reproduction, we replaced the usual speakers with top quality tactile transducers. Made by Aura, the "Bass Shaker" transducers are normally used to add the rumble to the chairs in flight simulators and high-end home theater systems. Because these transducers filter away any frequencies above 100 hertz they are poorly suited to playing music. However they were perfect for BETAR's pulse frequencies, which only range from 4 to 96 hertz.



The result was a BETAR system like never before – one that was all but silent but for the soothing hum of these seven low frequency tones. Don and Cindy's clients report feelings of relaxation and stress reduction that transcend even the tremendous healing powers of massage. And with Whisper Edition BETAR systems installed all five of their therapy tables, every massage and reflexology session can include the power of relaxation through resonance with BETAR.
